

Mission Awareness Event: Model 3 Sample Invite List

This is a sample list of individuals and groups to consider inviting, with a focus on key areas of involvement (this list reflects a broader range of individuals, and is not limited to only the following groups and individuals.):

1. Community Leaders

- Local influencers or people who can amplify the mission within their networks and communities. (e.g., City council members, mayors, or local politicians, etc.)
- Leaders of local chapters of national organizations (e.g., Rotary Club, Lions Club, Junior League, etc.)
- Public Safety Agencies (e.g., fire dept, police dept, etc.)

2. Youth and Family Professionals

- Educators and administrators who can identify children and families needing support.
 (e.g., teachers, guidance/adjustment counselors, principals, etc.)
- Youth coaches who work with young individuals and can encourage participation in community-driven efforts. (e.g., school, club, community center)
- Social workers or counselors specializing in child welfare, mental health, or community well-being.

3. Healthcare and Nonprofit Professionals

- Medical professionals, including doctors, nurses, and mental health practitioners, who
 may have an interest in community outreach or youth support.
- Nonprofit workers with expertise in community-building, advocacy, or outreach who can provide strategic support or advice.
- Event planners, marketing experts, or PR professionals who can offer guidance on event promotion and future initiatives.

4. Media and Influencers

- Journalists, bloggers, or other members of the press who could raise awareness about the mission and share it with their audience.
- Local celebrities, social media influencers, or public figures who have a following and could help generate interest and support.

5. Philanthropists and Donors

 Individuals or organizations with the capacity to provide financial support, donations, or resources to help further the mission's goals.

6. Local Community Supporters

 Parents and caregivers who are involved in their children's development and education are committed to supporting the mission. (e.g., PTA members, youth group leaders, etc.)



- Local business owners who might be interested in contributing to community initiatives, either through financial donations or in-kind support.
- Neighbors or residents of the local area who are curious about the mission and eager to learn more or contribute in some way.
